My first renewable project was as a Lessor on Spinning Spur-I, a 161MW windfarm, which went commercial in 2013. The Spinning Spur Ranch developed into a three phase, 254 turbine, 516MW windfarm owned and operated by Google (SS-1), EDF Renewables (SS-2), and Black Rock and EDF Renewables (SS-3).

Currently I am the manager of Goat Mountain Renewables, a greenfield development entity, which is to say I work to develop renewable utility generation facilities on land previously unused in commercial or industrial applications. We focus on single landowner assets, where we can establish site control for both generation and interconnection through lease options and right of way agreements.

Prior to my current role, I earned a Juris Doctor from Southwestern Law [2012], and was on Specialist Post 11 at the Pacific Stock Exchange, Los Angeles CA [1992-2002].

Outside of these professional pursuits, I cooked professionally at Joachim Splichal's Melrose Avenue Patina Restaurant [2003], founded a contemporary art gallery with spaces in Pasadena CA, and Shanghai, China [2004-07], and am an avid road cyclist [current].
